taught in the primary department the rudiments of an English education; in the intermediate department such branches as are not provided for in the primary department, and prerequisite to respectable English education; in the grammar department such higher studies as the board may deem proper, and in the high school department all of the branches prescribed as prerequisite for admission to the collegiate department of the University of Minnesota.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after

its passage.

CHAPTER 495.

AN ACT TO DETACH CERTAIN TERRITORY FROM THE VILLAGE OF JANESVILLE, IN WASECA COUNTY, IN THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, AND TO ATTACH THE SAME TO ADJOINING SCHOOL DISTRICT NUMBER TWENTY-NINE (29), IN SAID WASECA COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That the southwest quarter of the northwest quarter, and the northwest quarter of the southwest quarter of section thirty-five (35); also that portion of the northeast quarter of the southeast quarter of section thirty-four (34) lying and being south of the Winona and St. Peter railroad track, all in township one hundred and eight (108) north, range twenty-four (24) west, in said county of Waseca, state of Minnesota, and now being a part of the village of Janesville, in said county, be and the same is hereby detached from the said village of Janesville and attached to and made a part of the common school district number twenty-nine (29) in said Waseca county.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its

passage.
