## CHAPTER 546.

[H. F. No. 68.]

AN ACT ENTITLED "AN ACT TO LEGALIZE THE ACTION OF THE VOTERS OF THE VILLAGE OF RENVILLE, IN RENVILLE COUNTY MINNESOTA, IN VOTING TO ISSUE ITS BONDS FOR THE PURPOSE OF BUILDING A VILLAGE HALL AND THE ACTION OF THE VILLAGE COUNCIL IN ISSUING SAID BONDS PURSUANT TO SAID VOTE."

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota.

SECTION 1. WHEREAS, at a duly called special election held in the village of Renville, in Renville county, Minnesota, on the sixth (6th) day of April, eighteen hundred and eighty-eight (1888), for the purpose of voting upon the question of issuing the bonds of the said village for the purpose of building a village hall there were thirty-one (31) votes cast in favor of issuing said bonds and none against; and,

Whereas, pursuant to the will of the people as expressed by said election the village council of said village did on the first day of July, A. D. eighteen hundred and eighty-eight (1888), issue the bonds of the said village in the sum of nine hundred dollars (\$900) as follows: one bond of four hundred dollars (\$400) due July first (1st), A. D. eighteen hundred and ninety-eight (1898), and one bond of five hundred dollars (\$500), due July first (1st), nineteen hundred and eight (1908), payable to S. N. Olson or bearer.

Now, therefore, the action of the voters of said village in voting to issue said bonds and the action of said council of said village, in issuing said bonds is hereby legalized and confirmed and the said bonds are declared to be in all things valid and binding upon said village.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
