

CHAPTER 554.

[H. F. No. 231.]

AN ACT TO LEGALIZE A CERTAIN BOND THEREIN DESCRIBED, ISSUED BY THE TOWN OF McDONALDSVILLE, IN THE COUNTY OF NORMAN, AND STATE OF MINNESOTA.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota.

SECTION 1. That a certain bond of one thousand five hundred (1,500) dollars, numbered ten (10), and dated on the twenty-first (21st) day of December, A. D., one thousand eight hundred and eighty-eight (1888), issued by authority of the board of supervisors of the town of McDonaldsville, in the county of Norman, and state of Minnesota, for the purpose of refunding certain other bonds against said town is, together with the interest coupons thereto attached, hereby legalized and made a valid and binding debt against said town.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 555.

AN ACT ENTITLED AN ACT TO LEGALIZE THE ACTION OF THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF WATERTOWN, CARVER COUNTY, MINNESOTA, IN USING MONEY FOR THE PURPOSE OF AIDING THE WATERTOWN MILL ASSOCIATION TO ERECT A GRIST MILL IN SAID VILLAGE.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the acts of the village council of the village of Watertown, in Carver county, Minnesota, whereby it did during the years eighteen hundred and eighty-eight (1888) and eighteen hundred and eighty-nine (1889), appropriate of the funds of said village various sums amounting in the aggregate to the sum of twenty-eight hundred and fifty (2,850) dollars, for the purpose of enabling the Watertown Mill Association to build a grist mill in said village, for which the stock of said association has been issued to said village, be and the same is in all things legalized.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
