General Laws of 1859, repeal of Chap. 104, relating to election of village officers in Rock county.

AN ACT TO REPEAL CHAPTER ONE HUNDRED AND FOUR (104) OF THE GENERAL STATUTES OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-NINE (1889), AND TO RESTORE FOR ROCK COUNTY SECTION NINETEEN (19) OF CHAPTER ONE HUNDRED AND FORTY-FIVE (145) OF THE GENERAL STATUTES OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-FIVE (1885), AS AMENDED BY CHAPTER FIFTY-THREE (53) OF THE GENERAL STATUTES OF ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN (1887), AND SECTION TWENTY-ONE (21) OF THE SAME CHAPTER ONE HUNDRED AND FORTY-FIVE (145).

Be it enoded by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Restoring provisions of law of 1885, relating to villages, as amended by Chap. 53, General Lawsof 1887.

SECTION 1. That Chapter one hundred and four (104) of the General Statutes of one thousand eight hundred and eighty-nine (1889) be and the same is hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. That section nineteen (19) of Chapter one hundred and forty-five (145), as amended by the General Statutes of one thousand eight hundred and eighty-nine (1889), Chapter fifty-three (53), and also subdivisions eighteenth (18th) and twentieth (20th) of section twenty-one (21) of the same Chapter one hundred and forty five (145), be and the same are hereby revived and made applicable to all incorporated villages in Rock county, the same as previous to the enactment of said Chapter one hundred and four (104) of the Laws of one thousand eight hundred and eightynine (1889).

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
