## CHAPTER 430.

[H. F. No. 530.]

AN ACT TO REGULATE THE TAKING OF ICE FROM SILVER LAKE, RAM-SEY COUNTY, MINNESOTA.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. It shall hereafter be unlawful for any person or persons to cut, take or carry away, or otherwise meddle with, any ice on that body of water lying within the village limits of the village of North St. Paul, Ramsey County, Minnesota, known as "Silver lake," except it be done by and with the consent of the village council of said village, and then under such regulations and restrictions as have been or may hereafter be provided by ordinance of said village council.

SEC. 2. Any person violating the provisions of this act shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and on conviction thereof shall pay a fine of not less than five (5) nor more than fifty (50) dollars for each

offense.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 431.

[H. F. No. 749.]

AN ACT TO LEGALIZE THE EXPENDITURE OF THREE THOUSAND DOL-LARS (\$3,000) BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF RAMSEY COUNTY, DURING THE YEAR EIGHTEEN HUNDRED AND NINETY (1890), FOR THE BENEFIT OF CYCLONE SUFFEBERS.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesola:

SECTION 1. That the expenditure of the sum of three thousand dollars (83,000) by the board of county commissioners of the county of Ramsey, during the year eighteen hundred and ninety (1890), for the benefit of, and the appropriation of the same to the relief of, certain
