CHAPTER 190.

Minnesota Educational Association.

An act to provide for the publication of the proceedings of the Minnesota Educational Association.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Minnesota:

To publish proceedings.

SECTION 1. The state printing commission is hereby authorized and required to publish annually as public matter, five thousand (5,000) copies of the proceedings of the Minnesota Educational Association. The same to be distributed throughout the state by the executive committee of the said association.

Provided, that a copy of the proceedings of the said association shall be filed by the corresponding secretary or other officer of the said association, on or before the twenty-fifth (25) day of February of each year, with the secretary of state.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 191.

Liquor licenses

An act relating to the issuing of licenses for the sale of intoxicating liquors.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Minnesota:

Limitation.

SECTION 1. No license to sell intoxicating liquors at a place outside of the corporate limits of any incorporated city, village or borough and within a distance of fifteen hundred (1500) feet of any school house of any public or independent school district shall hereafter be issued to any person by the board of county commissioners of any county in this state.

SEC. 2. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent with the provisions of this act are hereby repealed.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
