SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from

and after its passage.

CHAPTER 259.

S. F. No. 197.

An act to regulate the sale of intoxicating liquors.

Intoxication liquors.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. Whenever the people of any village or Local option in villages and municipal township shall have voted against the issu-towns. ance of license for the sale of intoxicating liquors therein, it shall thereafter be unlawful for any person or corporation to sell, barter or give away the same therein at retail or wholesale in any quantity whatever; provided that nothing herein contained shall in any manner affect the provisions of chapter eight (8) of the general laws of one thousand eight hundred and eighty-seven. Provided that nothing in this act shall be construed to prevent or forbid any manufacturer of intoxicating liquor in any village or township from selling his product to be consumed outside of said village or township.

SEC. 2. Whoever violates the provisions of section one Penalty. (1) shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and shall upon conviction thereof in any court having jurisdiction of the same, be punished by a fine of not less than fifty (50) dollars nor more than one hundred (100) dollars, together with the costs of prosecution, and by imprisonment in the county jail for not less than thirty (30) days nor more than ninety (90) days.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
