An act to make adjacent lands to an incorporated vinages. village used as a cemetery a part of such incorporation.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Minnesota:

Section 1. That all lands adjoining any incorporated village cemevillage in this state used as a cemetery or for burial purposes, or that shall hereafter be used for such purpose, shall be and are hereby made a part of and included in such incorporation.

An act to validate the acts of villages heretofore at- Villages. tempting to be incorporated in Minnesota under an act entitled "An act to provide for the incorporation of villages and to define their duties and powers and to repeal certain laws in relation thereto being chapter one hundred and forty-five of the general laws of one thousand eight hundred and eighty-five, approved March 1st, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-five.

Whereas, certain villages have attempted to incorporate under and by virtue of chapter one hundred and forty-five (145) of the general laws of one thousand eight hundred and eighty-five (1885), being an act entitled "An act to provide for the incorporation of villages and to define their duties and powers and to repeal certain laws in relation thereto;" and,
