### CHAPTER 330.

S. F. No. 161.

*An act to legalize certain corporations and to validate transfers of property made by such corporations.*

Healing act.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That in all cases where an attempt has heretofore been made to form organize or renew any corporation under any of the general laws or statutes of the state of Minnesota, and the person so attempting to form, organize or renew any corporation have actually adopted, signed and filed in the office of the secretary of state, articles of incorporation in which the business therein specified was such as might be lawfully carried on under said laws by such corporation, and have in fact issued stock and transacted business under the corporate name therein assumed, and have in good faith received or transferred any property, real or personal, such attempted formation, organization or renewal in each and every such case is hereby legalized and declared valid and effectual under the name assumed as an incorporation under the laws of the state of Minnesota, notwithstanding the omission of any matter, thing or requirement by law prescribed to be done or observed in such formation organization or renewal thereof.

Legalizing de facto corporations.

And any and all conveyances of property, real or personal in good faith and lawful form made to or by any such body under the corporate name so assumed are hereby legalized and declared as valid and effectual for the purposes intended thereby as if such body corporate had been originally, in all things duly and legally incorporated *provided* that this act shall not apply to any suits now pending, involving the validity of such organization *Provided*, that this act shall not have the effect of reviving or renewing any corporation which has expired by limitation of time or shall have been dissolved by any court of competent jurisdiction.

Legalizing conveyances.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
