CHAPTER 331.

Healing act.

An act to legalize articles and acts of corporations organized under chapter twenty-three (23) of the general laws of eighteen hundred and sixty-seven (1867).

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Minnesota:

Corporations.

SECTION 1. That all articles of incorporation, amendments thereto, acts or by-laws of corporations organized and existing under and by virtue of the provisions of chapter twenty-three (23) of the general laws of the year eighteen hundred and sixty-seven (1867) of the state of Minnesota and of acts amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto, providing for the issue of capital stock by such corporations are hereby legalized and made valid and of the same force and effect as if such had been specifically provided by law.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from

and after its passage.

Every corporation created or organized under the laws of any other state or territory or foreign country before it shall transact any business in this state, or acquire, hold, or dispose of property, real, personal or mixed, within this state, shall appoint an agent in writing who shall reside at some accessible point in this state duly authorized by it to accept service of summons or process, and upon whom service of summons or process may be made in any civil action in which said corporation may be a party, the cause of which said action arose in this state, and service upon such agent shall be taken and held as due and sufficient service upon any such corporation. A duly authenticated copy of the appointment or commission of such agent shall be filed and recorded in the office of the sec-

retary of state and of the register of deeds of the county where said agent resides, and a certified copy thereof by
