Hillman for personal injuries sustained by him while in the performance of his duties as a member of the national guard of the state of Minnesota, by reason of the premature explosion of a cannon, whereby he was injured and incapacitated from labor for life.

CHAPTER 399.

Special appro-An act to appropriate money to reimburse John J. priation. Furlong, John D. Allen and Alexander (hisholm and Angus Haynes for expenses incurred in contests for a seat in the house of representatives.

> Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the sum of one thousand eight hun-John J. Furlong. dred (1,800) dollars be and hereby is appropriated out of the general revenue fund of the state, to reimburse John J. Furlong for expenses incurred by him in a contest for a seat in the house of representatives during the twenty-ninth (29th) session of the legislature of said state in the year eighteen hundred and ninety-five (1895).

SEC. 2. That the sum of twelve hundred and fifty John D. Allen. (1,250) dollars be and the same hereby is appropriated out of the general revenue fund of the state to reimburse John D. Allen for expenses incurred by him in a contest for a seat in the house of representatives during the twenty-ninth (29th) session of the legislature of said state in the year eighteen hundred and ninety-five (1895.)

SEC. 3. That the sum of six hundred (600) dollars be and hereby is appropriated out of the general revenue

fund of the state to reimburse Alexander Chisholm for expenses incurred by him in a contest for a seat in the house of representatives during the twenty-ninth. (29th) session of the legislature of said state in the year eighteen hundred and ninety-five (1895).

SEC. 4. That the sum of four hundred and fifty-five ADgus Haynes. (455) dollars be and is hereby appropriated out of the general revenue fund of the state to reimburse Angus Haynes for expenses incurred by him in a contest for a seat in the house of representatives during the twentyninth (29th) session of the legislature of said state in the year eighteen hundred and ninety-five (1895).

CHAPTER 400.

An act to approviate the sum of one hundred (\$100) special approdollars to pay Max Manzel for loss incurred by the destruction of a collection of flora by the fire in the state university in eighteen hundred and ninety-four (1894).

The sum of one hundred (100) dollars Max Manzel. be and the same is hereby appropriated out of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, to pay Max Manzel for a collection of flora burned in the fire at the state university in the year eighteen hundred and ninety-four (1894).

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
