CHAPTER 404.

Special appro-
priation.

An act for the relief of Lieut. William H. Caine, surgeon of the First Battalion of Artillery, Minnesota National Guard.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Minnesota:

Lieut. Wm. H.
Caine.

SECTION 1. That the sum of five thousand (\$5,000) dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated out of any money in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, for the relief of Lieut. William H. Caine, for personal injuries sustained by him while in the performance of his duties, as a member of the National Guard, of the state of Minnesota, by reason of being thrown from his horse, whereby he was injured and incapacitated from following his profession for life.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 405.

Special appro-
priation.

An act to appropriate money to reimburse Professor Otto Luggen for moneys expended during the year 1894 to exterminate chinch bugs in different counties of this state.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Minnesota:

Prof. Otto
Luggen.

SECTION 1. That the sum of three hundred and forty-six dollars and ninety cents (\$346.90) is hereby appropriated out of moneys in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, to reimburse Professor Otto Luggen for moneys expended by him during the year eighteen hundred and ninety-four (1894) at the request of the governor of this state for the extermination of chinch bugs in the different counties of this state.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
