#### CHAPTER 42.

H. F. No. 70.

*An act to amend section thirty (30) of chapter thirty-four (34) of the general statutes of the State of Minnesota eighteen hundred and seventy-eight (1878), relating to the filing of awards by commissioners in condemnation proceedings.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section thirty (30) of chapter thirty-four (34) of the general statutes of eighteen hundred and seventy-eight (1878) be and the same is hereby amended by adding thereto the following proviso.

*Provided, however, that for good cause shown the court may by order extend the time for the making of said report for a further period not to exceed three (3) months.*

*An act to amend chapter twenty-one (21) of the general statutes one thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight (1878) of the State of Minnesota, relating to weights and measures.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That chapter twenty-one (21) of the general statutes one thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight (1878) of the state of Minnesota be, and the same is hereby amended by adding thereto the following provision, to-wit:

Sec. 14. None of the provisions of this act shall be construed to prevent the vendor from recovering from the vendee the reasonable value or the agreed price for the actual quantity of personal property, merchandise,
