

## CHAPTER 71.

S. F. No. 10.

*An act to amend sections one (1) and four (4) of chapter seventy-six (76) of general laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-three (1883) concerning mutilated, lost and destroyed bonds orders and warrants.*

To amend Secs.  
1 and 4 Chap.  
76 G. L. 1883.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section one (1) of chapter seventy-six (76) of the general laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-three (1883) be and the same is hereby amended by inserting the words "incorporated village, municipality" between the word "city" and the word "township" in the second line of said section.

SEC. 2. That section four (4) of said section seventy-six (76) be and the same is hereby amended by inserting the words "incorporated village, municipality" between the word "city" and the word "township" in the twelfth (12th) line of said section.

SEC. 3. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with the provisions of this act are hereby repealed.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 72.

S. F. No. 546.

*An act to amend section thirty (30) of chapter one hundred and forty-five (145) of the general laws of 1885, entitled, An act to provide for the incorporation of villages and to define their duties and powers and to repeal certain laws in relation thereto.*

To amend Sec.  
30 Chap. 145  
G. L. 1885.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section thirty (30) of chapter one hundred and forty-five (145) of the general laws of 1885 be amended so as to read as follows:

Sec. 30. The village council may cause any street or any part of any street to be graded, paved, macadamized or otherwise improved, or any sidewalk or gutter to be built, upon a petition therefor in writing, signed by at least a majority of all the owners of real estate bounding both sides of such street or part of street to be improved; or order any sidewalk or gutter on one (1) side of a street to be built, on the petition of a majority of such owners, and may order any sidewalk
