Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Minnesota:

Section 1. That section number one hundred and eighty-two (182) of the "probate code" of the state of Minnesota be amended so as to read as follows:

Sec. 182. An executor, administrator, or guardian, appointed in another state upon any estate where there trator or is no executor, administrator, or guardian appointed in guardian appointed and pointed and this state, may file an authenticated copy of his appoint- leensed to sell. ment in the probate court for any county in which there is real estate of the deceased, or of the ward or wards of such guardian; after which he may be licensed by the same probate court to sell such real estate for the payment of debts, legacies and charges of such administration, "ward or wards, and to obtain means to support and maintain the ward or wards of such guardian, in the same manner, and upon the terms and conditions as are prescribed in the case of an executor, administrator or guardian appointed in this state, except as hereinafter provided.

And such foreign executor administrator; or guardian may act by his attorney in fact thereto by him duly appointed by power of attorney, under his hand and seal, and executed and acknowledged in the same manner as is required for all conveyances of real estate, which power of attorney shall be recorded in the office of the register of deeds for the county in which the real estate

is situated.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That section nine of chapter forty-six of the general laws of eighteen hundred eighty-nine, entit-
