

sessed valuation of the county at the time of their issue, and notwithstanding it may require a tax levy of more than one mill upon the dollar of the taxable property in any one year to meet the payment of principal and interest when the same comes due; *provided* this act shall not apply to any suit now pending relative to the legality of any bonds so issued.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 148.

H. P. No. 1025.

*An act to amend title C of chapter one hundred and sixty-two (162) of the general laws of 1891, relating to an appropriation to build a bridge in Mower county.*

Bridges in

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That title C of chapter one hundred and sixty-two (162) of the general laws of 1891 be amended so as to read as follows:

Sec. 1. That the sum of eleven hundred dollars (\$1100) is hereby appropriated out of the internal improvement fund for the purpose of building bridges in Mower county under the direction of the board of county commissioners of said county.

SEC. 2. Upon the receipt of a sworn statement signed by the chairman of the board of county commissioners of said county, to the effect that the amount appropriated by the provisions of this act has been expended by the commissioners of said county for bridge purposes, the state auditor shall thereupon issue a warrant in the sum of eleven hundred dollars (\$1100) payable to the county treasurer(s) of said Mower county.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
