

CHAPTER 197.

H. F. No. 602.

An act appropriating six hundred and forty-five dollars and sixty cents (\$645.60) to reimburse Hon. E. S. Hall, contestee, for attorney's fees and expenses in the legislative contest from the 45th legislative district; Joseph H. Coates contestant against E. S. Hall.

\$645.60 appropriated for E. S. Hall.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the sum of six hundred and forty-five dollars and sixty cents (\$645.60) be and the same is hereby appropriated out of any money in the state treasury, applicable for that purpose, to reimburse Hon. E. S. Hall, member from the 45th legislative district, contestee in the legislative contest wherein Joseph H. Coates was contestant and Hon. E. S. Hall was contestee. And the state auditor is hereby authorized to draw a warrant on the state treasurer in favor of said Hon. E. S. Hall for the said sum of six hundred and forty-five dollars and sixty cents (\$645.60).

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 198.

H. F. No. 372.

An act to amend section 35, chapter 36 of the general statutes 1878, being section 3701, general statutes of 1894, relating to common school districts and providing for annual reports of school treasurers.

Common school dists.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section thirty-five (35), chapter thirty-six (36) of the general statutes of eighteen hundred and seventy-eight (1878), being section three thousand seven hundred and one (3701), general statutes of eighteen hundred and ninety-four (1894), be amended so as to read as follows:

"The treasurer shall present and file with the clerk of every common school district three (3) days before each annual meeting a report in writing signed by him and containing a statement of all moneys received by him within the year preceding and of all his disbursements,

Annual report of treasurer.
