from the road funds under their control for the purpose of constructing and repairing bridges located within villages as they are authorized to make for purpose of constructing and repairing bridges not built within the limits of any incorported village. No overseers of highways shall be elected in or for any such village, but the poll tax shall be collected as hereinafter provided, and shall be expended, and the streets, highways and public places governed by the village council and officers of their appointment.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from

and after its passage.

CHAPTER 235.

Inebriate dep'ts of Rochester asylum abolished. An act to abolish all special departments for the treatment of inebriates in the Rochester state hospital for the insane.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That all special departments for the treatment of inebriates for the Rochester state hospital for the insane be and the same are hereby abolished; and that the further care and treatment of inebriates at said hospital be and the same is hereby prohibited.

SEC. 2. That all acts and parts of acts that are inconsistent with the provisions of this act be and the same are hereby repealed.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

Transcribing records in new counties.

An act to amend section six hundred thirty-two (632) of general statutes of Minnesota, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-four (1894), relating to transcribing records in newly organized counties.
