CHAPTER 103.

Independent school districts. An act providing for the issue of bonds for the purchase of sites and erecting school houses in independent school districts, and to repeal chapter three hundred and fifty-nine (359) of General Laws of Minnesota for 1897.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota;

School house sites, how procured.

SECTION 1. That in all cases where the legal voters of any independent school district shall have, at a legally called meeting, by a majority vote, authorized the purchase of a site or sites, and the erection thereon of a school house or school houses, and designated the amount of money to be raised for such purposes, the board of education of such independent school district may issue bonds of such district for the amount so designated, which bonds shall be signed by the president and clerk of such board of education. Such bonds shall be payable in such amounts and at such times, with such interest not exceeding five (5) per cent. per annum, as the board of edution may direct, and shall not be sold for less than their par value.

C. 359, Laws 1897, repealed. SEC. 2. That chapter three hundred and fifty-nine (359) of the General Laws of Minnesota for the year 1897 be and the same is hereby repealed.

Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 104.

Newly organized countles. An act to amend chapter ninety-nine (99) of the General Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-seven (1897), relating to newly organized counties.
