## CHAPTER 188.

An act to amend section four thousand four hundred and eightecn (4418) of the General Statutes of one thousand cight hundred and ninety-fow (1894), relating to clerk hire for probate judges.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That section four thousand four hundred and eighteen (4418) of the General Statutes of one thousand eight hundred and ninety-four (1894), is hereby ansended so as to read as follows:

Sec. 4418 . All probate judges whose salary exceeds the sum of one thousand $(1,000)$ dollars, may receive a further sum to be annually fixed by the board of county commissioners, not exceeding five humired (500) dollars, in any one year, for clerk hire.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 189.

An act to amend section fifty-five (55), chapter four, of General Laves of the State of Minmesota for the year one thousand eight hundred and ninety-three (1893), being section sixty (60) of the Statutes of Minuesota for one thousand eight hundred and nincty-four (1894), relating to elections.

Be it enacted by the Jegislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That section sixty (60) of the General Statutes of one thousand eight hundred and ninety-four (1804) be amended so as to read as follows:

Sec. 60. Except in cities of over twelre thousand ( 12,000 ) inhabitants, the board of registration in each election district in the state at least twenty (20) days before any election, shall make a list or register of the names of all persons who are entitled to vote in their respective districts at such election, which list shall contain the surname of such persons in their alphabetical order, and
