SEC. 12. A room which shall serve as an office for the commission shall be provided for in the new capitol building.

SEC. 13. Said commission may from time to time, as needed, draw their order in favor of the parties to whom money is due, or to one of the members of said commission when the money is to be used for incidental expenses, stating in said order what the money is to be used for, and upon the presentation of such order the state auditor shall draw his order on the state treasurer for the amount thereof, not exceeding the amount herein appropriated for the purpose.

SEC. 14. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 354.

H. F. No. 363.

An act to repeal section twenty (20) of sub-chapter seven (7) of chapter seventy-four (74) of the General Laws for the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-seven (1877), relating to the appointment of school examiners for independent school districts.

School examiners for independent districts, abolished.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section twenty (20) of sub-chapter seven (7) of chapter seventy-four (74) of the General Laws of the State of Minnesota for the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-seven (1877) be and the same is hereby repealed.
