SEC. 6. That for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of this act, any citizen of this state may, and it is hereby declared to be the duty of the attorney general, to institute, in the name of the state, proceedings in any court of competent jurisdiction against any person, partnership, association or corporation who may be guilty of violating any of the provisions of section one (1) of this act, for the purpose of imposing the penalties imposed by this act, or securing the enforcement of section three (3) hereof. *Provided*, that when such proceedings are instituted by any one other than the attorney general, the state shall not be in any manner liable for the costs or for any of the expense of such proceedings. And *provided, further*, that when the attorney general deems it necessary, he is hereby authorized to employ counsel to assist in the prosecution of any action brought under the provisions of this act.

SEC. 7. The word person as used in this act shall be construed to include any corporation or association formed or existing under any law of this state or any other state or country.

An act to fix the time for holding the general terms of the district courts in and for the Eighth judicial district.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. The general terms of the district court in and for the counties of the Eighth judicial district shall be held as follows:

In the county of Carver on the first (1st) Monday in March and the last Monday in September of each year.

In the county of Le Sueur on the second Monday in February and the second Monday in September of each year.

All writs, recognizances and all other papers and proceedings made returnable to the district court of either of said counties constituting the said judicial district and all continuances and notices made or taken thereto shall be considered and deemed to be returnable to the next terms of such courts as they are fixed by this act.

SEC. 3. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this act are hereby repealed.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 361.

First judicial
district, terms
of court in.

An act to fix the times for holding regular terms of the district court of the First judicial district of Kanabec county, for the hearing and trial of all matters, except issues of fact by the jury.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. A regular term of the district court of the First judicial district shall be held in the county of Kanabec in addition to the general term of said court in said county now provided by law on the fourth (4th) Tuesday of April in each year for the trial of issues of fact by the court without a jury, for the trial of issues of law, the hearing of motions, applications and all matters except the trial of issues of fact by jury.

Such term of said court shall be known and called special term.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
