An act to provide punishment for illegal voting at Hegal voting school meetings.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. Whoever not being a qualified voter, and Penalty for, not entitled to vote at a school meeting, held in any school prisonment. district, shall with unlawful intent vote at any such school meeting, or on any question, or for the election of any officer to be elected at such school meeting, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and on conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not to exceed one hundred (100) dollars, or imprisonment in the county jail for not exceeding three months.

CHAPTER 99.

An act to amend section sixty-eight hundred fifty-seven cars and (6857), General Statutes eighteen hundred and ninety-four (1894), relating to the getting on and off moving cars or engines.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section sixty-eight hundred and fiftyseven (6857), General Statutes eighteen hundred and ninety-four (1894), be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

Sec. 6857,

It shall be unlawful for any person, other than pas- Unlawful for sengers or employes, to get on or off, or attempt to get playes or on or off, or to swing on or hang on from the outside of, passengers to any engine or car or any electric motor or street car upon while in any railroad or track, while such engine, car, motor or street care is in motion, switching or being switched.
