CHAPTER 151.

An act to provide stationery, postage and necessary office supplies for all county officers, including the district judges of said county, in all counties of the state which now have, or which may hereafter have, a population of one hundred and fifty thousand inhabitants or over.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Commissioners to furnish stationery, SECTION I. The county commissioners in all counties of the state now having, or which may hereafter have, a population of one hundred and fifty thousand inhabitants or over, are hereby authorized and directed to furnish all county officers, including the judges of the district court of said counties, all necessary office supplies, postage and stationery, including letterheads and envelopes.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 152.

An act to provide for holding meetings of stockholders of corporations which have failed or neglected to hold annual meetings as provided by law.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION I. Whenever any corporation organized un-

der the laws of this state shall have failed or neglected to hold its annual meeting for two consecutive years, a meeting of the stockholders thereof may be called in any manner as follows, viz.: A notice signed by stockholders holding one-third of the stock in such corporation, stating the time and place of holding such meeting, shall be published in a newspaper printed and published in the county where the principal office of such corporation is.

Service of notice.

SEC. 2. Such notice shall also be served at least ten days prior to the date of such meeting, upon the president or secretary of such corporation by the sheriff of the county in which the principal office of such corporation is located, if he can be found in such county, and the return of the sheriff thereto shall be prima facie evidence of the facts stated therein.
