

lessee or his contractor, the lien herein provided for shall only be a lien upon the interest of such lessee, and shall not effect the rights or be an incumbrance upon the interests of the owner of such mine or land.

This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 339.

S. F. No. 322.

An act entitled an act fixing the amount of the official bonds of county treasurers in all counties that now have or that hereafter may have over one hundred and fifty thousand, and not more than two hundred thousand inhabitants.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That in all counties of this state which now have or hereafter may have by the last completed state or national census a population of over one hundred and fifty thousand (150,000), and not more than two hundred thousand inhabitants, the official bond of the county treasurer shall be in the sum of five hundred thousand (\$500,000) dollars, *provided* that when the surety upon the official bond of any such treasurer is a corporation duly authorized by the laws of this state to become such surety, the amount of such bond shall be in the sum of two hundred and fifty thousand (\$250,000) dollars.

SEC. 2. This act shall be in force and effect from and after Jan. 1, 1905.

SEC. 3. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
