

from special assessments, and also for the increased cost of sewers which are larger than two feet in diameter; and the proceeds of said bonds or any thereof shall not be used for any other purpose than those hereinbefore specified.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

### CHAPTER 35.

Bridge  
across Root  
river in  
Houston  
county.

*An act to amend section thirty-one (31) of chapter three hundred and nine (309) of the laws of 1901, relating to the appropriation for building a bridge across Root river, in the township of Mound Prairie, Houston county, Minnesota.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota

SECTION 1. That section 31 of chapter 309 of the laws of 1901 be amended to read as follows:

\$500.

That the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500) is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the state treasury belonging to the internal improvement fund, or out of the first moneys which shall come into the state treasury belonging to said fund, not otherwise appropriated to aid in repairing or rebuilding, as the case may be, a bridge over Root river, in the township of Mound Prairie, Houston county, Minnesota, at a point in section thirty-one (31), township one hundred and four (104), range five (5), Houston county, Minnesota.

That said sum shall be expended under the direction of the supervisors of Mound Prairie township, and when said work is completed said supervisors shall certify the fact to the state auditor, who shall draw his warrant upon the state treasurer, for said amount in favor of said town.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
