

CHAPTER 358.

H. F. No. 328.

An act to appropriate money for the construction of a State House in Itasca State Park.

Itasca
State
Park.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the sum of five thousand dollars (\$5,000) is hereby appropriated out of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of building a state house in Itasca State Park, for the accommodation of the park commissioners and visitors.

Said amount of money may be expended under the direction of the governor and attorney general in the construction of a state house and necessary appurtenances, in the purchase of furnishings therefor and the improving of the grounds, upon the shore of Itasca Lake in said park, upon a site heretofore selected by the attorney general.

Said expenditures shall be audited by the state auditor and paid out upon vouchers duly approved by the governor and attorney general.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 359.

H. F. No. 331.

An act to amend section 2 of chapter 186 of the Gen. Laws of Minnesota for 1895, as amended by chapter 192 of the Gen. Laws of Minnesota for 1897, being an act entitled: An act to provide for special instruction in the common school branches in state high schools, and to appropriate money for the same.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section 2 of chapter 186 of the General Laws of Minnesota for 1895, as amended by chapter 192 of the General Laws of Minnesota for 1897, be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

"Sec. 2. That whenever the board of education in any city or village in the State of Minnesota, in which there is a state high school, having a four (4) years course, and classes doing work in each of the four (4) grades
