Incorporation of villages in certain cases.

## CHAPTER 370.

An act to extend the application of certain provisions of chapter 145 of the General Laws of 1885, the same being sections 1240 to 1245, both inclusive, of the General Statutes of 1894, relating to the incorporation, powers and duties of villages in certain cases.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION I. That the provisions of sections 23 to 28 both inclusive of chapter 145 of the General Laws of 1885, the same being sections 1240 to 1245, both inclusive, of the General Statutes of 1894, relating to the incorporation, powers and duties of villages in certain cases, providing for the acquisition by agreement, purchase or condemnation of private property for public use by certain villages therein mentioned, be and the same are hereby extended to all villages within this state, however organized.

SEC. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with the provisions of this act are hereby repealed.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 371.

An act to legalize sheriff's certificate in certain cases.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION I. That no certificate heretofore executed undef and by virtue of section six thousand thirty-eight (6038), chapter eighty-one (81), title one (1), Statutes of Minnesota, of one thousand eight hundred ninety-four (1894), shall be deemed invalid by reason of the same not having been made, executed, proved or acknowledged and recorded within the twenty days (20) mentioned in said section: or by reason of the affidavit of costs and disbursements as provided in section 6051 of the General Statutes of 1894 having been filed after the expiration of ten (10) days, and the record of all such certificates and affidavits heretofore executed, proved or ac-
