

finances of the county at the end of the fiscal year, including all debts and liabilities of every description and the assets and the other means to discharge the same; and shall, within thirty days thereafter, have the same posted up at the court house door, and at two other public places in their county, and published in some newspaper therein, if there is one, for three successive weeks. Said board shall, at its meeting in September and January of each year, examine and count all the funds in the treasury, and shall examine the accounts and vouchers of the auditor and treasurer, and make a written certificate of the condition of the treasury, and file the same with the auditor, showing how much money and what kind is in the treasury, and all other matters in connection therewith. *Provided*, that in all counties of over 75,000 inhabitants such proceedings shall be published in a daily newspaper."

CHAPTER 391.

H. F. No. 691.

An act to appropriate money for the purchase of land at the Rochester state hospital for the insane.

Land for
Rochester
hospital.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That from any money in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of twelve hundred (1200) dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated, to be used by the state board of control for the purchase of additional lands at the Rochester state hospital for the insane.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
