

CHAPTER 9.

S. F. No. 100

An act to amend section No. 4915 of the General Statutes of 1894, with reference to the time of holding the terms of the district court in the several counties of the Fifth Judicial District of the State of Minnesota.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. The general terms of the district court in and for the Fifth Judicial District in and for the counties of Dodge, Rice, Steele and Waseca shall be held in said counties as follows:

Terms of court in 5th district.

In the county of Dodge on the first Monday in April and the first Monday in October of each year.

Dodge.

In the county of Rice on the first Tuesday in May and the second Tuesday after the first Monday in November of each year.

Rice.

In the county of Steele on the first Tuesday in June and the fourth Tuesday in November of each year.

Steele.

In the county of Waseca on the third Tuesday in March and the third Tuesday in October of each year.

Waseca.

SEC. 2. All writs, processes, orders, continuances, appeals, bonds, recognizances, notices of proceedings issued, made or returnable to the general terms of court in and for said counties, respectively, as prescribed by law prior to the taking effect of this act, shall be deemed and construed as made, taken and returnable to the proper term of court of the counties, respectively, as prescribed in this act.

Writs, etc., returnable.

SEC. 3. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this act are hereby repealed.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
