

mission under this act, with an itemized account of its expenditures, and containing a statement of the ownership whether by the state or by private owners, of all lands which will require to be taken or interfered with, according to the report of the engineers, in order to establish said system of drains, which report shall embody the maps and report of the engineer or sufficient thereof to enable the Legislature to obtain an intelligent idea of the subject, together with such suggestions and recommendations as the commission may think proper. A sufficient number of copies of the report of said commission shall be printed and supplied to the members of the legislature which will convene in the year nineteen hundred seven (1907), and the various officers and boards of the state.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 160.

H. F. No. 56

An act to appropriate money to reimburse certain persons for supplies furnished to the Minnesota National Guard at its encampment at Lake View, in July, 1896.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. The sum of two hundred fifty-four (\$254) dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby authorized and directed to be paid by the Minnesota National Guard, out of any funds heretofore or hereafter appropriated to said National Guard, to reimburse the persons hereinafter mentioned, in the amounts respectively set down opposite their names, for supplies furnished by them to the Minnesota National Guard at its encampment at Lake View in the month of July, eighteen hundred ninety-six (1896); said amounts and each of them to be disbursed by the adjutant general as follows:
