CHAPTER 174.

An act permitting any weekly newspaper to change its day of publication without losing its standing as a legal newspaper.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Changing day of publication. Section 1. It shall be lawful for any legal weekly newspaper in this state to change its day of publication without losing its standing as a legal newspaper, and the publication of any legal notice affected by such change of day of publication is hereby made valid.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 175.

Court house bonds. An act to authorize the board of county commissioners of any county not already owning a county court house, to issue its bonds, and to use the proceeds thereof for the building of a county court house.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Action by Co. Comrs. Section 1. The board of county commissioners of any county of the State of Minnesota which does not already own a county court house, is hereby authorized and empowered to issue the bonds of said county to such an amount as, in its judgment, may be necessary, but not exceeding one per cent of the assessed valuation of its real and personal property, as fixed by the last preceding assessment for general taxation, for the purpose of building a county court house in said county.

Bonds and interest. SEC. 2. The said bonds shall be in such sums as the board of county commissioners shall determine, and shall bear interest at a rate, not exceeding six per cent per annum, payable semi-annually, such interest to be evidenced by interest coupons to be attached to such bonds. The principal shall become due and payable at such time or times as the said board of county commissioners may by resolution determine, not less than five (5) or more than twenty (20) years from the date of issue of said bonds respectively.
