

village shall be apportioned to the general revenue fund of the city, borough or village where the real estate is situated, and all other penalties, costs and interest collected on real estate taxes shall be apportioned one-half to the county revenue fund and the other half to school districts of the county in the manner provided for the distribution of other school funds by section 3763 of the General Statutes of 1894 as amended by chapter 49 of the General Laws of 1897.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 240.

S. F. No. 372.

An act to fix the salary of the members of the railroad and warehouse commission, and appropriating the necessary money therefor.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. Beginning with May 1st, 1905, the annual salary of each member of the railroad and warehouse commission shall be thirty-six hundred dollars, payable in the same manner as are salaries of other state officers. The necessary funds to pay the same are hereby annually appropriated out of any funds in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated.

SEC. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this act are hereby repealed.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
