CHAPTER 248.

An act to amend chapter 327, General Laws 1903, entitled "An act to amend section seventy-four of chapter 175 of the Laws of 1895, entitled an act to revise and codify the insurance laws of the state." This amendment relates to the publication of the annual statement of insurance companies as required in said act.

Insurance.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION I. That section I of chapter 327 of the General Laws of 1903, amending section 74 of chapter 175 of the General Laws of 1895 be amended so as to read as follows:

Company's statement.

Section 74. Every insurance company doing business in this state must transmit to the insurance commissioner a statement of its condition and business for the year ending on the 31st day of December. Said statement

must be published in the county of the company's home office, if within the state, otherwise in each of the two most populous counties of the state, and in all cases for at least three successive weeks, once in each week, in a legal newspaper; and provided further, that when the said statement is published in each of the two most popu-

lous counties of the state under the provisions of this act such statement must be published in a daily news-

paper conforming with the requirements of section 7992

of the General Statutes of 1894. All statements for publication shall be made out on blanks furnished by the

Blanks,

insurance commissioner and under his direction, and the insurance commissioner's certificate of authority to do business in this state shall be published in connection with said statement of each company doing business in this state.

Proof of publication, to-wit, the printer's affidavit of the fact shall be filed with the insurance commissioner in all cases.

In case such statement is not published by the company, or its agent, and proof of publication filed as required within sixty days from the date of filing the statement with the insurance commissioner it shall be the duty of the insurance commissioner to have the same published as provided in this section, and collect the cost of said publication from the company.

Insurance commissioner to cause publication.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, A. D. 1905.
