CHAPTER 79.

Salary of
Co. boards
of control.

An act to fix the salaries of the members of the board of control of any county and to authorize any such board to fix the salary of the almshouse and hospital physician appointed by it.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. The salary of each member of the board of control of any county in this state shall be \$600 per annum; and each such board is authorized to fix the salary of the almshouse and hospital physician appointed by it at such sum not exceeding \$5,000 per annum, as the board may deem proper. The salaries named herein shall be payable monthly out of the funds appropriated on account of salaries, or otherwise, for the maintenance of the board.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 80.

An act relating to expenditure of the county road and bridge fund, and to repeal sections one (1) and three (3) of chapter 287 of the General Laws of 1895.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Appropriations

SECTION 1. Whenever the board of county commissioners of any county shall determine to expend any portion of the county road and bridge fund, not exceeding the sum of three hundred dollars (\$300), to aid in the construction or repair of roads and bridges in any town of such county, the same shall be appropriated and expended as hereinafter provided and not otherwise.

SEC. 2. Whenever any board of county commissioners shall make an appropriation, not exceeding the sum of three hundred dollars (\$300), out of the road and bridge fund of such county, to aid in the construction and repair of roads and bridges, or either, in any town of such county, the board of county commissioners making such appropriation shall direct the county auditor of such county to draw a warrant on the treasurer of such county for the amount of such appropriation, making the same
