## CHAPTER 116-H. F. No. 448.

An Act anthorising the appointmont and fixing the salary of an assistant comty attorncy in all comnties in the State of Mimesota, having a population of one hundred and fifty thousand inhabitants and not more than trio hundred thousand inhabitants. Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

County attorney may appoint assistant at $\$ 1,800$ per annum.-Section 1. That all counties in this state, that now have or may hereafter have, according to the last completed national census, a population of not less than one hundred and fifty thousand $(150,000)$ and not more than two hundred thousand $(200,000)$ inhabitants, the county attorney is hercby authorized to appoint an additional assistant, who shall be known as the second assistant county attorney, and whose salary shall be fixed and is hereby fixed at eighteen hundred $(1,800)$ dollars per annum, which salary shall be payable out of the county treasury in equal monthly installments.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and aiter its passage.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:
Board to elect officers-duties of secretary.-Section 1. Section two thousand three hundred and fourteen (2314) of chapter thirty-five (35) of the Revised Laws of the State of Minnesota for the year 1905 shall be amended to read as follows:
