

shall keep a proper record showing the collections and expenditures of such road taxes in each road district, and shall, at the annual town meeting, present a complete report of such collection and expenditures for the previous year.

In towns containing two or more congressional townships said road taxes shall be expended in the township in which the said taxes are levied.

Sec. 2. This act shall only apply to such road taxes as are levied during the year 1907 and thereafter.

CHAPTER 286—H. F. No. 627.

An Act entitled, An act to authorize any city in the State of Minnesota now or hereafter having a population of over fifty thousand inhabitants to provide necessary funds for the support and maintenance of its fire department, and to fix the maximum expenditure each year thereof.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Council to fix maximum expenditure for fire department.

—Section 1.* That any city in this state now or hereafter having a population of over fifty thousand inhabitants, in addition to all powers now possessed by it, shall have the power and authority, acting by and through its common council, to fix the maximum expenditure each year for the support and maintenance of its fire department, and to include the amount so fixed in the current annual tax levy for such city.

Sec. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
