dollars, to aid in building a bridge across the Root river at a point in section sixteen (16), township one hundred and three (103), range nine (9), near the village of Whalen, in the town of Holt, in said county.

Said money to be expended under the supervision of the board of supervisors of said town.

The sum of two hundred and seventy-five (275) dollars, to aid in reconstructing and rebuilding the approaches of the bridge over Camp creek on the Preston and Lanesboro road in the town of Preston.

Said sum shall be expended under the supervision of a committee consisting of H. Nupson and A. D. Gray.

CHAPTER 85—H. F. No. 260.

An Act to amend section 957, Revised Laws 1905, providing fees for serving notices of expiration of redemption from tax sales.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That section 957, Revised Laws 1905, be amended to read as follows:

Sheriffs' fees for serving notices.—Section 957. Fees for Notice.—For serving such notice the sheriff shall receive that same fees as for the service of summons in a civil action in the district court, except that where more than one notice is served upon one person or corporation at the same time and place the sheriff shall be entitled to charge but one mileage. Such fees and the printer's fees for publishing such notice shall be paid in the first instance by the holder of the tax certificate, and repaid by the party offering to redeem such land before a certificate of redemption shall issue.
