

CHAPTER 261—H. F. No. 888.

An Act to amend sub-section 4 of section 784, Revised Laws 1905, which authorizes school districts to issue bonds for certain purposes.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

What school district bonds may be issued—Purpose.—Section 1. That sub-section 4 of section 784 of the Revised Laws, 1905, shall be, and the same hereby is amended to read as follows:

“4. School districts.—In the case of school districts, including special and independent districts, whether lying within a city or village or not, for the purchase of sites for school houses, and for defraying the expenses incurred and to be incurred in building, rebuilding, remodelling, repairing and furnishing school houses, and installing heating, ventilating and plumbing plants in the same, and equipping the same with libraries, apparatus and other school furniture.”

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 262—H. F. No. 212.

An Act to repeal chapter one hundred and sixty-one (161) of Session Laws of the State of Minnesota for the year one thousand nine hundred and seven (1907), entitled, “An Act to prohibit the issuance of non-participating policies by certain life insurance companies.”

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Chapter 161, Session Laws 1907, repealed.—Section 1. That chapter one hundred and sixty-one (161) of Session Laws of the state of Minnesota for the year one thousand nine hundred and seven (1907), be and the same is hereby repealed.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
