CHAPTER 388-S. F. No. 343.

An Act to amend section 423, Revised Laws, 1905, as amended by chapter 204, General Laws, 1907, relating to salaries of county commissioners.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Salaries of commissioners in counties having assessed valuation of more than \$20,000,000 and not exceeding 100,000,000, \$800.—Section 1. That section 423, Revised Laws, 1905, as amended by chapter 204 of the General Laws of Minnesota for the year 1907, be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

Section 423. Each commissioner shall receive from the county, in full payment for all his services, an annual salary as follows:

In counties whose assessed valuation does not exceed two million five hundred thousand dollars, the sum of one hundred twenty-five dollars.

In counties whose assessed valuation is more than two million five hundred thousand dollars and does not exceed seven million dollars, the sum of one hundred seventy-five dollars.

In counties whose assessed valuation is more than seven million dollars and does not exceed twenty million dollars, the sum of two hundred fifty dollars.

' In counties whose assessed valuation is more than twenty million dollars and does not exceed one hundred million dollars. eight hundred dollars.

In counties whose assessed valuation is more than one hundred million dollars, one thousand two hundred dollars. And said one thousand two hundred dollars shall be in full for all services upon the county and other boards and committees, and all traveling and other expenses within the county.

Except as otherwise provided, commissioners shall also reecive ten cents per mile travel each way for every mile necessarily traveled in attending the meeting of the board, or in discharge of official duty under the direction of the board; but no commissioner shall receive mileage for attending more than twelve sessions of the board in counties whose assessed valuation does not exceed one hundred million dollars; provided, that where any district includes a city of the third class having more than five thousand inhabitants, the salary of the commissioner therein shall be fixed by the county board at its first meeting in each year, but shall not exceed two hundred fifty dollars.

Sec. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this act are hereby repealed.

Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
