CHAPTER 1—H. F. No. 53.

An act to appropriate money for the payment of salary of Lieutenant Governor and the salary and Mileage of members of the legislature and for the payment of the per diem of the officers and employes of and all other expenses of the legislature, including payment of necessary supplies therefor.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Appropriation for Legislative expenses.—That the sum of \$150,000.00 or so much thereof as may be found necessary, be and the same hereby is appropriated from the revenue fund for the payment of the salary of the Lieutenant Governor and the salary and the Mileage of the members of the legislature and for the payment of the per diem of the officers and employes of, and all the other expenses of the legislature, including payment of necessary supplies therefor.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
