 Itasca county, on the third Tuesday in March and the *third* Tuesday in *October*.
 Koochiching county, on the second Tuesday in June and the second Tuesday in January."

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 144—H. F. No. 732.

An act authorizing certain special school districts to levy taxes for school purposes.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **Certain special school districts may levy 35 mills for general purposes.**—Any special school district now or hereafter having not less than ten thousand inhabitants nor more than fourteen thousand inhabitants is hereby authorized to annually levy for general school purposes a tax of not to exceed thirty-five mills on the dollar of the valuation of all taxable property in said district, according to the preceding official assessment thereof; provided that this act shall not be applicable to any district the boundaries of which are coterminous with the boundaries of any city.

Sec. 2. **Inconsistent acts repealed.**—All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with the provisions of this act are hereby repealed.

Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 145—H. F. No. 715.

An act validating certain conveyances of real property and the record thereof.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **Certain conveyances of real property legalized.**—That all conveyances made and executed in the month of July 1916,
