

Monday of January, 1921, and the advertisement for sale thereof shall be valid and sufficient for all purposes, and said certificates, so executed, shall be valid and legally binding obligations of the state of Minnesota.

Sec. 3. **Inconsistent acts repealed.**—All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with the provisions of this act are hereby repealed.

Sec. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 15—S. F. No. 5.

An act to amend paragraph 6 of Section 9412 of the General Statutes of Minnesota, 1913, relating to legal holidays.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **Armistice Day Legal Holiday.**—That Paragraph 6 of Section 9412 of the General Statutes of Minnesota, 1913, be amended to read as follows:

6, holidays—The word "holiday" shall include New Year's Day, January 1, Lincoln's Birthday, February 12; Washington's Birthday, February 22; Memorial Day, May 30; Independence Day, July 4; Labor Day, first Monday in September; election day, the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November of the even numbered years; Christmas Day, December 25; the Friday next preceding Easter Sunday and commonly known as Good Friday; and *Armistice Day, November 11th*. No public business shall be transacted on those days, except in cases of necessity, nor shall any civil process be served thereon.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 16—S. F. No. 42.

An act to authorize the County Board in any County now having or hereafter having a population of not more than two hundred twenty-five thousand and an assessed valuation of more than \$300,000,000, exclusive of Money and Credits, to cause to be printed and bound in permanent form, with a suitable index therein, for the use of the County officers and employes of any such County, copies of the official proceedings of said County Board and of the annual financial statement of said County and for the printing of the official canvass of the primary and general elections in any such County as part of the County Board proceedings and ratifying and confirming all payments heretofore made by any such County Board in good faith for the printing of such proceedings.
