

Section 1. County board may appropriate money to aid in the construction of inter-state bridges.—The County Board of any county may appropriate and expend from its county road and bridge fund, including such sums as are allotted or apportioned to it from the state road and bridge fund, such sums of money as it may deem proper for the construction and maintenance, in conjunction with any adjoining state or any political sub-division thereof, of the one-half of a bridge across any river forming a boundary line between this state and any other state. Any such bridge when constructed as a terminus of an existing state road, or when constructed, with the approval of the Highway Commissioner, as the terminus of a road which is not a State road, shall be for all purposes regarded as state road construction by such county to the extent of the amount contributed.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 382—S. F. No. 1186.

An act to amend Chapter 467 of the Session Laws of 1921 relating to education and state aid for schools.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Special aid for classes for deaf in public schools.—That paragraph (a) of subdivision e of Section 10 of Chapter 467 of Session Laws of 1921, be amended to read as follows:

“(a) For deaf children, two hundred fifty dollars (\$250) for each such child, *who is enrolled in a day school and who is a resident of a district maintaining such school, and four hundred dollars (\$400) for each child who is a non-resident of the district maintaining such school and whose resident district does not maintain such school; the additional one hundred and fifty dollars (\$150) to be paid for board and room of such non-resident child.*”

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 383—S. F. No. 1204.

An act to appropriate money to Jacob E. Hiebert and David Vogt in payment to them of the Minnesota soldiers' bonus.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Appropriation for soldiers' bonus.—That the sum of \$180 is hereby appropriated to Jacob E. Hiebert and the sum of \$110 is hereby appropriated to David Vogt, payable out of the
