Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Town boards authorized to appropriate money for county roads.—That any town in this state may at its annual meeting determine to authorize the town board to expend, through the county board of the county in which such town is situated, funds of the town for the construction, improvement and maintenance of roads within such town, with the construction, improvement and maintenance of which said town is charged by law.

Sec. 2. Same.—That upon such determination by the annual meeting of any such town, the town board shall have authority to appropriate and pay to such county moneys from the town road and bridge fund for the construction, improvement or maintenance of any road, with the construction, improvement or maintenance of which said town is charged by law, and that said moneys so appropriated shall be credited to the road and bridge fund of said county and shall be expended in the construction, improvement and maintenance of such road or roads as shall be designated by such town boards; provided, however, that no such appropriation shall be made except with the consent of the county board of such county.

CHAPTER 58-H. F. No. 587.

An act to appropriate money for the purpose of creeting and equipping main buildings at the teachers' colleges at Winona and Mankato including heating plant and providing for issuing of certificates of indebtedness to cover the cost thereof, and legalizing certain proceedings heretofore had in reference to the erection of such buildings.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. State Teachers' Colleges—Appropriation for new building.—The sum of one million and fifty-four thousand dollars (\$1,054,000,00) or so much thereof as may be necessary is hereby appropriated out of moneys in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated for the purpose of erecting and equipping main buildings at the Teachers' Colleges at Winona and Mankato including new heating plant at Winona Teachers' College as follows:

A. Three hundred and sixty-two thousand dollars (\$362,-000.00) of the amount so appropriated is to be used for the purpose of erecting and completing the main building at Mankato, and the amount heretofore used and appropriated from the State Treasury in the sum of two hundred and thirty-three thousand dollars (\$233,000.00) by the State Teachers' College Board and Board of Control for the purpose of commencing the erection of a main building at said Mankato, Minnesota, is hereby in all things legalized, ratified and confirmed.

Sec. 2. Board of Control to direct expenditures.—The money so appropriated is to be spent by the State Board of Control as now provided by law.

Sec. 3. Certificates of indebtedness to be issued.—For the purpose of providing in part the money so appropriated by the provisions of this act, the State Auditor is hereby authorized to issue and sell upon competitive bids, certificates of indebtedness in the sum of nine hundred ninety thousand dollars (\$990,000.00), such certificates of indebtedness to be due and payable as follows:

\$120,000.00 August 1, 1924 80,000.00 February 1, 1925 120,000.00 August 1, 1925 80,000.00 February 1, 1926 120,000.00 August 1, 1926 80,000.00 February 1, 1927 120,000.00 August 1, 1927 80,000.00 February 1, 1928 120,000.00 August 1, 1928 70,000.00 February 1, 1929

Said certificates of indebtedness shall be in such form as the State Auditor may determine and shall be signed by the president of the State Teachers' College Board and countersigned by the State Auditor, who shall keep a proper register thereof showing the date of issue, the amount and rate of interest the same bears and the date of maturity thereof and a certificate of such registration shall be endorsed thereon.

- Sec. 4. Denominations and interest rates.—Said certificates of indebtedness shall be issued in denominations of not less than one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) and shall bear interest at not to exceed five per cent (5%) per annum, payable semi-annually, and the proceeds of the sale thereof shall be deposited in the State Treasury to the credit of the State Teachers' College Fund, to be expended as provided by law and by the provisions of this act; provided, that the certificates, or any portion thereof, may be purchased for the state's trust funds without first asking for bids.
- Sec. 5. To be issued as required.—Said certificates of indebtedness shall only be issued and sold from time to time as the actual work progresses and only in such sums as may be required to provide the necessary funds to pay for materials and labor ac-

tually furnished and other necessary expenses authorized by this act

on proper action by the proper authorities.

Sec 6. Tax levy authorized.—For the purpose of paying the certificates of indebtedness herein described the State Auditor is hereby authorized to levy the necessary tax upon all the taxable property of the state to pay said certificates win interest. The sum necessary to meet interest becoming due prior to the collection of taxes for such purpose, and for printing of the certificates, is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated.

Sec. 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after

its passage.

Approved March 13, 1923.

CHAPTER 59-H. F. No. 103.

An act to appropriate money for the payment of salaries and expenses of employees of the state auditor for examining, appraising and selling state land, estimating and selling timber and detecting trespass upon and caring for state lands.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Appropriation for examining, appraising and selling State land.—That the sum of twenty thousand (\$20,000) dollars, or so much thereof as may be found necessary, be and the same hereby is appropriated from any moneys in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, for the payment of salaries and expenses of employees of the state auditor for examining, appraising and selling state land, estimating and selling timber, and detecting trespass upon and caring for state lands.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after

its passage.

Approved March 14, 1923.

CHAPTER 60-H. F. No. 140.

An act to amend Chapter 246, Session Laws of Minnesota, 1919, being an act to fix the salaries of county boards in all counties having not less than 55 nor more than 57 congressional townships, and having an assessed valuation of not less than \$5,000,000 nor more than \$10,000,000., and to provide for the payment of their expenses.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Salaries of county boards in certain counties.— That Chapter 246, Session Laws 1919, be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:
