## CHAPTER 105—S. F. No. 926.

An act authorizing the Governor of the State of Minnesota to deed to the city of St. Cloud, Minnesota, certain real estate belonging to the State of Minnesota in said city of St. Cloud in consideration of the vacation of certain streets and alleys in said city by the governing body thereof by which complete title to said streets and alleys is vested in the State of Minnesota.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. State to deed certain property to City of St. Cloud. -In consideration of the vacation of certain streets and allevs in the city of St. Cloud, Minnesota, to-wit, twenty (20) feet on the south side of Ninth Street South between Second and Third Avenues South and all of Second Avenue South between Ninth and Tenth Streets South and also the alley running north and south through the center of Block Twenty-one (21) in Curtis Survey in said city of St. Cloud, Minnesota, authority is hereby given to the governor of the State of Minnesota, upon satisfactory evidence being produced to him that said vacations aforesaid have in fact been made by said city of St. Cloud, to convey to the said city of St. Cloud by good and sufficient deed, the following property belonging to the State of Minnesota, to-wit: The South Twenty (S. 20) feet of Lot numbered Six (6) and the South Twenty (S. 20) feet of Lot numbered Twelve (12), all in Block numbered Twenty (20), in the Town of Saint Cloud City (now a part of the City of Saint Cloud, Stearns County, Minnesota), according to a map and survey of said Town made by T. A. Curtis, on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for Stearns County, Minnesota.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after

its passage.

## CHAPTER 106—S. F. No. 178.

(Sec. 872, Note, G. S. 1923.)

An act repealing Chapter 424, General Laws 1923, fixing the salary of treasurers in certain counties, and Chapter 425, General Laws 1923, relating to clerk hire in the office of county treasurer in certain counties.

Be it enacted by the Leislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Laws repealed.—That Chapter 424, General Laws 1923, and Chapter 425, General Laws 1923, be and the same are hereby repealed.
