congressional townships, and having a population of not less than 30,000 nor more than 45,000 inhabitants, and having an assessed valuation of not less than \$20,000,000 nor more than \$40,000,000 each county commissioner shall receive from the county in full payment for his services an annual salary of \$800, except that such commissioners may be allowed and paid in addition thereto their actual and necessary traveling expenses incurred and paid by them in the discharge of their official duties, provided that the total aggregate amount of traveling expenses of the county commissioners of any such county which may be so allowed and paid shall not exceed the sum of \$1200 in any one year. Provided this act shall not apply to any county in which the salaries of county commissioners are now fixed by special law."

CHAPTER 82-S. F. No. 619.

An act fixing the clerk hire of the county treasurer in counties now or hereafter having not less than thirty-eight nor more than forty-two full congressional townships and now or hereafter having a taxable valuation of not less than \$8,000,000.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Clerk hire for county treasurer in certain counties.—In each county of this state now or hereafter containing not less than thirty-eight nor more than forty-two full congressional townships and now or hereafter having a taxable valuation of not less than \$8,000,000, there shall be allowed and paid as clerk hire in the office of the county treasurer one-sixth of a mill on each dollar of the assessed valuation of said county as fixed by the Minnesota Tax Commission for the preceding year. Such clerk hire shall be paid in equal monthly installments to the person or persons actually rendering service as such clerk in the same manner as the salary of other county employees.

Sec. 2.' This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
