

Sec. 2. That general statutes 1923, Section 478, be and the same hereby is amended so as to read as follows:

"478. The secretary of state shall call to his assistance two or more judges of the supreme court and two disinterested judges of the district court, and they shall constitute the state canvassing board. He shall appoint a meeting of such board to be held in his office on the *second* Tuesday after each general election, and within thirty days after a special election. When a vacancy in the membership of said board occurs by reason of inability or failure of any such judge to attend on the day appointed, he shall fill the vacancy by selecting another disinterested judge from either court; Provided, that not more than two judges of the supreme court shall be obliged to serve upon such board at one time."

#### CHAPTER 281—S. F. No. 1205

*An act authorizing the village council in villages having a population of more than 12,000 and an assessed valuation of more than \$60,000,000.00, to provide for the payment of certain salaries to the members of the water, light, power and building commission of such village.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Villages may pay salaries in certain cases.—That in all villages having a population of more than 12,000 and an assessed valuation of more than \$60,000,000.00, the village council of such village be authorized to provide for the payment of salaries to the members of the water, light, power and building commission of such village, such salaries to be set by such village council and paid from the water and light fund of said village, provided, however, that the salary to be paid the chairman of such commission shall not exceed the sum of \$150.00 per month and the salary of the other members of such commission shall not exceed the sum of \$100.00 per month.

Sec. 2. This act shall be in effect from and after its passage.
