CHAPTER 410—H. F. No. 1352

An act to appropriate money for the payment of salary of the Lieutenant Governor and the salary and mileage of members of the Legislature and for the payment of the per diem of the officers and employes of and all other expenses of the Legislature, including payment of necessary supplies therefor.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Appropriations for legislature expense.—That the sum of \$50,000.00 or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same hereby is appropriated from the revenue fund for the payment of the salary of the Lieutenant Govenor and the salary and mileage of the members of the Legislature and for the payment of the per diem of the officers and employees of, and all the other expenses of the Legislature, including payment of necessary supplies therefor; provided that the moneys so appropriated shall be used and expended as prescribed by the rules and joint rules of the respective bodies of the Legislature, and each such body is authorized to make payments for salaries and other expenses in conformity with its rules and joint rules and its regulations.

CHAPTER 411—H. F. No. 1353

An act to provide a levy of taxes for state purposes for the fiscal years ending June 30, 1930, and June 30, 1931.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Tax levy for year ending June 30, 1930.—For the purpose of defraying the expenses of the State for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1930, a tax of Five Million, Nine Hundred Twenty-one Thousand, Nine Hundred Seventy-six (\$5,921,976.00) dollars, or as near that amount as practicable, shall be levied on all taxable property of the state; provided, that the tax hereby levied shall not exceed the rate of three and one-tenth (3.1) mills on each dollar of taxable property.
