CHAPTER 43—S. F. No. 183

An act to validate and legalize certain street improvement certificates of indebtedness issued by any borough for purpose of paving streets.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **Certificates of Indebtedness validated.**—That all street improvement certificates of indebtedness issued by any borough in this state for the purpose of paving streets, in attempted compliance with the provisions of Chapter 65, General Laws 1919, and acts amendatory thereof, be and the same are hereby legalized and declared valid obligations of said borough of the same kind and character and with the same effect as though such borough had been authorized to issue such certificate of indebtedness pursuant to said chapter as amended; provided that no provision of this act shall apply to any action or proceeding now pending in any of the courts of this state.

CHAPTER 44—H. F. No. 182

An act to authorize any city of the third or fourth class to contract for the use of its sewers by the owner or occupant of land outside and within one mile of the limits of such city and to validate any such contract heretofore made.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **Certain cities may contract use of sewers.**—Any city of the third or fourth class may contract for the use of its sewers by the owner or occupant of land outside and within one mile of the limits of such city. Any such contract heretofore made is hereby validated and confirmed. Provided nothing herein shall be construed as limiting any power now possessed by any such city under its home rule charter.
